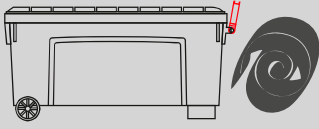


Preparation

1 | UNFOLD

Remove PNH Inflatable Pavilion from its trolley and unfold the inflatable tube.



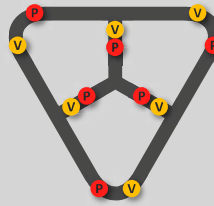
2 | POSITIONING

Make sure all the valves are facing upwards.



3 | TIGHTEN VALVES

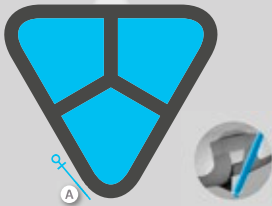
Each segment has 1 inflate / deflate valve and 1 overpressure valve. Tighten the overpressure valves.



4 | ANCHORING

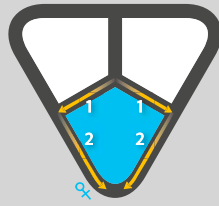
First anchor the leg that is facing the wind.

- Sand or snow
- Grass
- Solid Ground

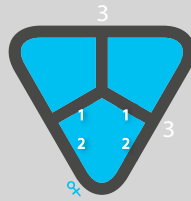


5 | BANNERS

On the inflatable tube, you will notice inner and outer zippers. Use the outer zippers to connect the banner to the segment.

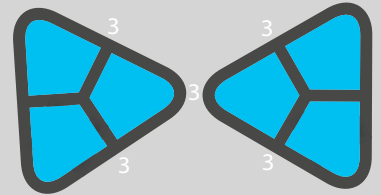


Start by zipping the top (1), and then zip the bottom (2). Repeat for each segment.

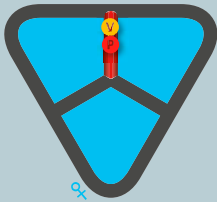
6 | ADD CONNECTING PIECE
Once the 2nd Pavilion is set up next to the 1st, join them together, by zipping the connecting piece to the sides (3) of each Pavilion.



Inflate

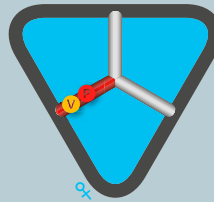
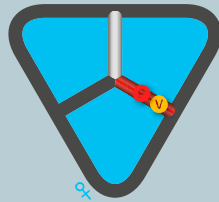
7 | INFLATE ROOF

Plug the electrical pump firmly in one of the open valves. Inflate the 3 roof segments one by one.



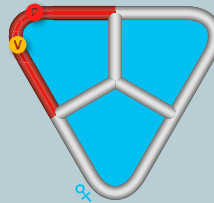
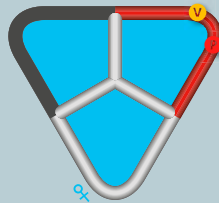
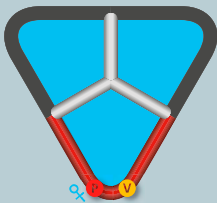
ABOUT THE PRESSURE

Inflate until the tube feels very solid (3PSI/0.2 BAR).
The remaining air will escape through the overpressure valve.



8 | INFLATE LEGS

Plug the electrical pump firmly into one of the open valves. Inflate the 3 leg segments one by one.



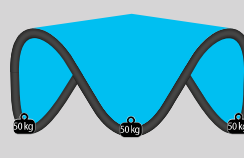
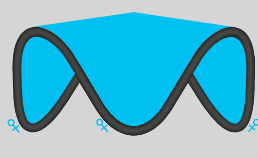
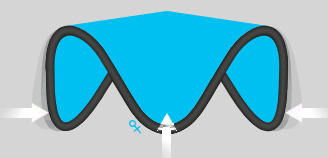
9 | POSITIONING LEGS

Push the 3 legs about 1 foot (30cm) to the center of the PNH Inflatable Pavilion for a symmetric shape.
Anchor the remaining legs.



10 | ANCHORING

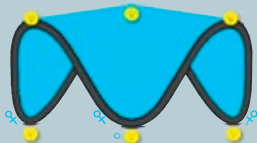
Always anchor the PNH Inflatable Pavilion by using the 2 remaining anchorpoints.
Place the pegs deeply into the ground and under an angle of 40 degrees.



Deflate

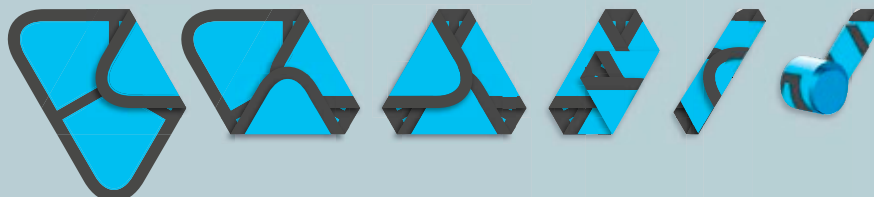
10 | DEFLATE

Deflate PNH Inflatable Pavilion by opening the six inflation valves. Do not remove the overpressure valves.

11 | FOLD



12 | STORAGE

DO NOT STORE THE PNH INFLATABLE PAVILION WHEN IT'S WET. Hang both frame and cloths in a dry environment.



Do's and don't's



Do not use sharp objects



Do not use chemicals for cleaning



Do not use open fire or heated objects



Do not store the PNH Inflatable Pavilion when it's wet



Can be used in a strong breeze.



Pressure (3PSI/0.2 BAR)



Anchor with pegs



Anchor with concrete blocks





DO NOT USE IN HIGH WINDS.

NEVER LEAVE THE PNH INFLATABLE PAVILION UNATTENDED.

AFTER USE, STORE IT IN A DRY PLACE. NEVER STORE IT WET. HANG THE FABRIC AND THE INFLATABLE TUBE IN A DRY AND WARM PLACE.

TO CLEAN, WASH IT IN COLD WATER WITH A SOFT HANDBRUSH AND/OR A WET CLOTH. DO NOT USE ANY CLEANING PRODUCTS. DO NOT PLACE IN WASHING MACHINE/DRYER.
